- During the Meeting via Oral Comments: When the Chair calls for public comment, attendees can queue to speak with the "Raise Hand" feature. On the Zoom application, click the "Raise Hand" button. On the phone, press \*9. The Secretary to the Board will call speaker names and unmute speaker microphones. You will have up to 2 minutes to provide your comments, with time set by the discretion of the Mayor. Please note, if you chose to make comments orally, your written comments will not be read but will be included in the final record.

In an effort to ensure the virtual process closely follows our normal process, public comment will be accepted in writing during the meeting, but may not be read into the record during the meeting, but will be included as part of the final administrative record. **3. BUSINESS ITEMS**

- A. MINOR USE PERMIT APPLICATION NO. MUP-20-07: CITY OF SEASIDE, PROPERTY OWNER, AND BLACK & VEATCH, APPLICANT ON BEHALF OF MONTEREY COUNTY IT DEPARTMENT, HAS APPLIED FOR MINOR USE PERMIT APPROVAL TO REPLACE AN EXISTING 30' TALL PUBLIC RADIO TRANSMISSION TOWER WITH AN 80' RADIO TRANSMISSION TOWER; AND TO INSTALL A NEW RADIO EQUIPMENT SHELTER, A NEW GENERATOR WITH ASSOCIATED 500 GALLON PROPANE TANK, AND TO ERECT AN 8' TALL FENCE TO SECURE THE PROJECT SITE. THE PROJECT SITE IS LOCATED NORTH EAST OF THE INTERSECTION OF COE AVENUE AND GENERAL JIM MOORE BOULEVARD (APN# 031-151-058-000), IMMEDIATELY WEST OF AN EXISTING WATER FILTRATION FACILITY IN THE OPEN SPACE – RECREATION ZONING DISTRICT.**

**RECOMMENDATION:** In accordance with Seaside Municipal Code section 17.18.020.A, Table 2-7 - *Allowed Land Uses and Permit Requirements for Special Purpose Zones*, a Minor Use Permit is required for a "Public or quasi-public serving uses" in the Open Space - Recreation zone. In accordance with SMC 17.62.070.C. Minor Use Permits are approved or denied by the Zoning Administrator (SMC 17.62.070.B).

Staff recommends approval of Minor Use Permit-20-07 subject to Attachment 1: Draft Resolution and Exhibit A to Attachment 1: Project Plans.
