During the Meeting via Oral Comments: When the Chair calls for public comment, attendees can queue to speak with the "Raise Hand" feature. On the Zoom application, click the "Raise Hand" button. On the phone, press *9. The Secretary to the Board will call speaker names and unmute speaker microphones. You will have up to 2 minutes to provide your comments, with time set by the discretion of the Chair. Please note, if you chose to make comments orally, your written comments will not be read but will be included in the final record.

In an effort to ensure the virtual process closely follows our normal process, public comment will be accepted in writing during the meeting, but may not be read into the record during the meeting, but will be included as part of the final administrative record.
