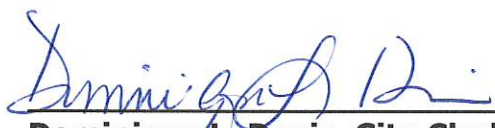

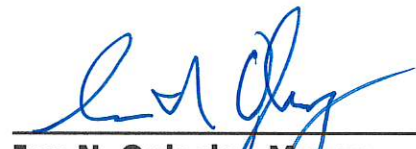
12. ADJOURNMENT
