RECOMMENDATION: Receive direction from subcommittee on options and logistics explored for hosting a community listening session on the state of homelessness in the City of Seaside.

C. **REVIEW HOMELESS ADVOCACY ORGANIZATIONS AND NON-PROFITS OPERATING IN THE CITY OF SEASIDE SERVING AT-RISK AND HOMELESS STUDENTS AND ALLOCATE UP TO \$5000 OF THE HOMELESS COMMISSION ANNUAL BUDGET TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF BACKPACKS, SCHOOL SUPPLIES, AND CLOTHING.**

RECOMMENDATION: Select projects serving at-risk and homeless young people operating in the City of Seaside and allocate up to \$5000 for the purchase of backpacks, school supplies, and clothing.

RECOMMENDATION: Receive a report from Commissioner Mugan to discuss allocating part of the Homeless Commission 2022/2023 fiscal year budget for holiday donations to support advocacy organizations and non-profits operating in the City of Seaside who serve homeless individuals and families.
