6. STAFF COMMUNICATION

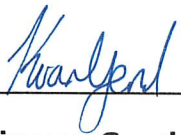
Assistant Engineer Leslie Llantero announced the upcoming community meeting on the Hilby Avenue Traffic Calming Project taking place on May 17, 2023.

Chair Pacheco requested staff look into painting over abandoned MST bus stops throughout the city to provide additional street parking.

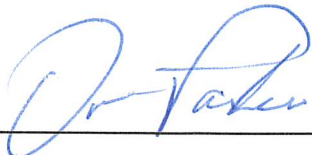
