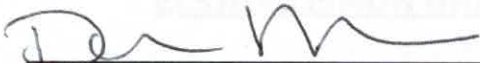

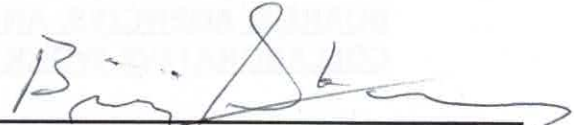
10. ADJOURNMENT
