**SUBJECT: CONSIDER THE INSTALLATION OF RED CURB AT 1184
BARBARA COURT**

PURPOSE & RECOMMENDATION

The purpose of this item is to have the Traffic Advisory Committee consider the installation of red curb at 1184 Barbara Court, Seaside, CA 93955.

BACKGROUND

Staff received the Traffic Advisory Committee Request Application (attachment 1), dated September 30th, 2024, from a resident requesting the installation of red curb on the west side of the driveway at 1184 Barbara Court. The resident noted their driveway is on the rounded portion of a Cul-du-sac and vehicles parking up to the driveway apron project into the exit path of the driveway partially blocking the driveway and making it difficult to exit. Blocking the driveway impacts the property owner's ability to use their property, and in particular the ability to park off the street and use the driveway. In addition blocked driveways impede emergency evacuation, and first responder access.

Staff conducted a site visit at 1184 Barbara Court at 9:00am on October 11th at 9:00am, and compiled a report (attachment 2). During the site visit, it is noted that the area was not heavily impacted with vehicles parking on the street. It was also noted that the Applicants driveway exits the court at a sharp angle, and cars parking at the driveway apron to the west of 1184 Barbara court would project into the driveway exit path.

Barbara Court is classified as a local road, with a speed limit of 25 miles per hour (mph) allowing one lane of traffic in each direction. Barbara court is an oval shaped cul-de-sac approximately 138ft long and 69ft wide with the approach street approximately 33 ft wide measured from face-of-curb to face-of-curb. Parallel parking is available on both sides of the street. The driveways are generally two car driveways serving two car garages, however the driveway curb cuts are only sized for a single car. Sidewalks

measuring approximately 5 feet wide are present on both sides of the street. Single-family residences are located along this block of Barbara Court. The applicant's driveway is approximately 11 feet wide at the face of curb, and the approach width at the curb is approximately 14 feet. The applicant's driveway is located on the rounded portion of the cul-de-sac leaving the street at almost a 40deg angle. The distance to the next driveway approach is approximately 17 feet to the west and 9 feet to the east. There is inadequate space for parking on either side. A standard parallel parking space is 20 feet long. The 17 ft curb length to the west of the Applicants driveway is smaller than a conforming parallel space, but is large enough to encourage illegal parking. There is no red curb in the vicinity of 1184 Barbara Court at this time. Adding red paint to either the east or west side of the driveway will not take a conforming parking space. Partial red striping will leave the remaining curb small enough that it discourages even small vehicles from trying to fit, but still allows motorcycles.

Staff reviewed past consultations with a traffic engineer from the City's On-call Traffic Engineering list. The consultant had provided examples of driveway red tipping and red curb recommendations from nearby Bay Area cities. Factors to consider when evaluating red curb for driveways include visibility from the driveway, maneuverability into and out of the driveway, width of the driveway, and the length of the adjacent curb for parking spaces. Placing red curb on either side of this driveway approach would assist with the applicant's ability to maneuver in and out of the driveway, as well as improve visibility when exiting the driveway.

Staff recommends installing 10 feet of red curb on the west side of the driveway at 1184 Barbara Court and red tipping the west side. This recommendation will not reduce the number of viable parking spots available on the street, allows motorcycle parking in the remaining curb space, and will prevent cars from parking where the vehicle blocks access to the 1184 Barbara court driveway.

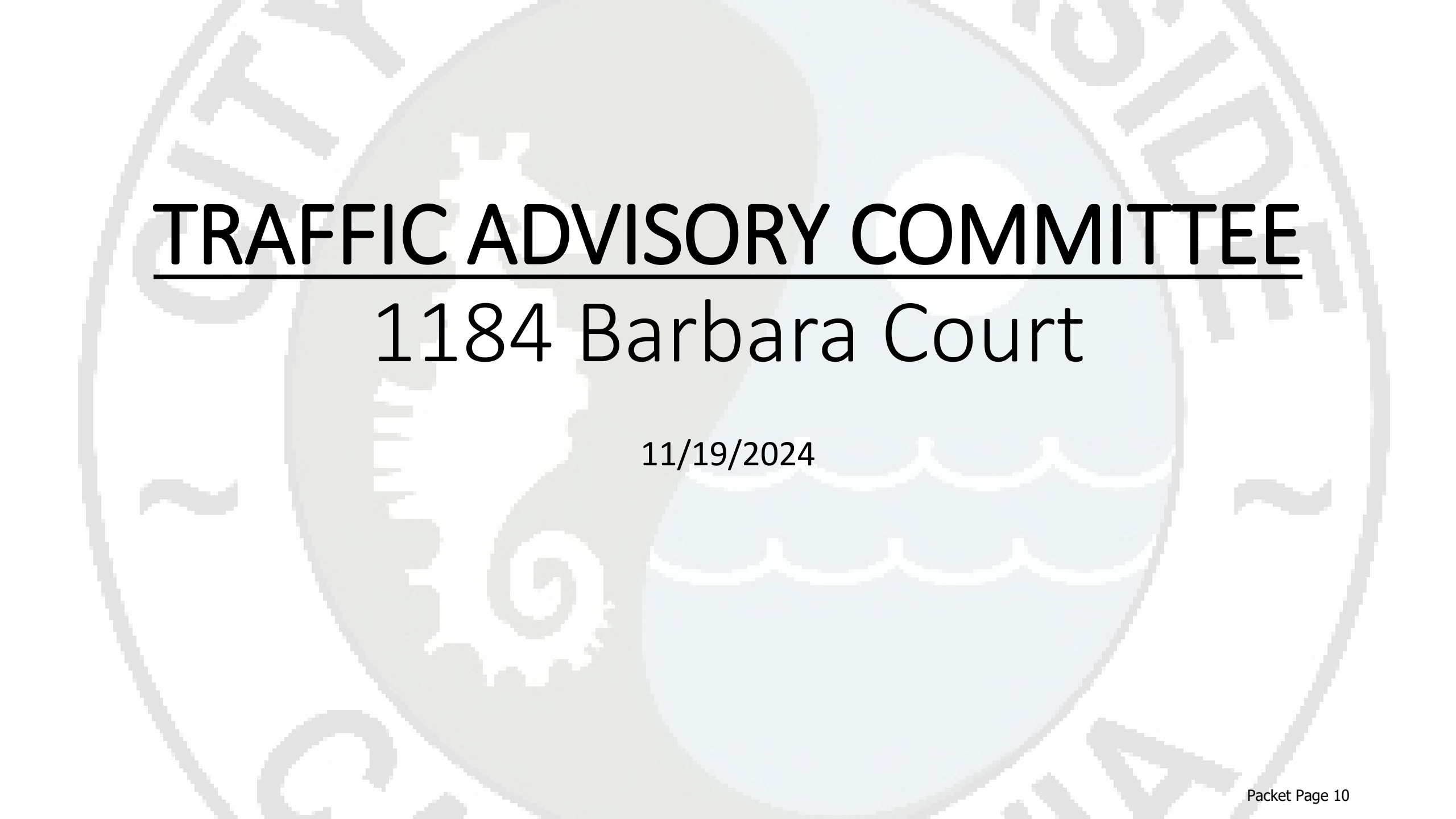

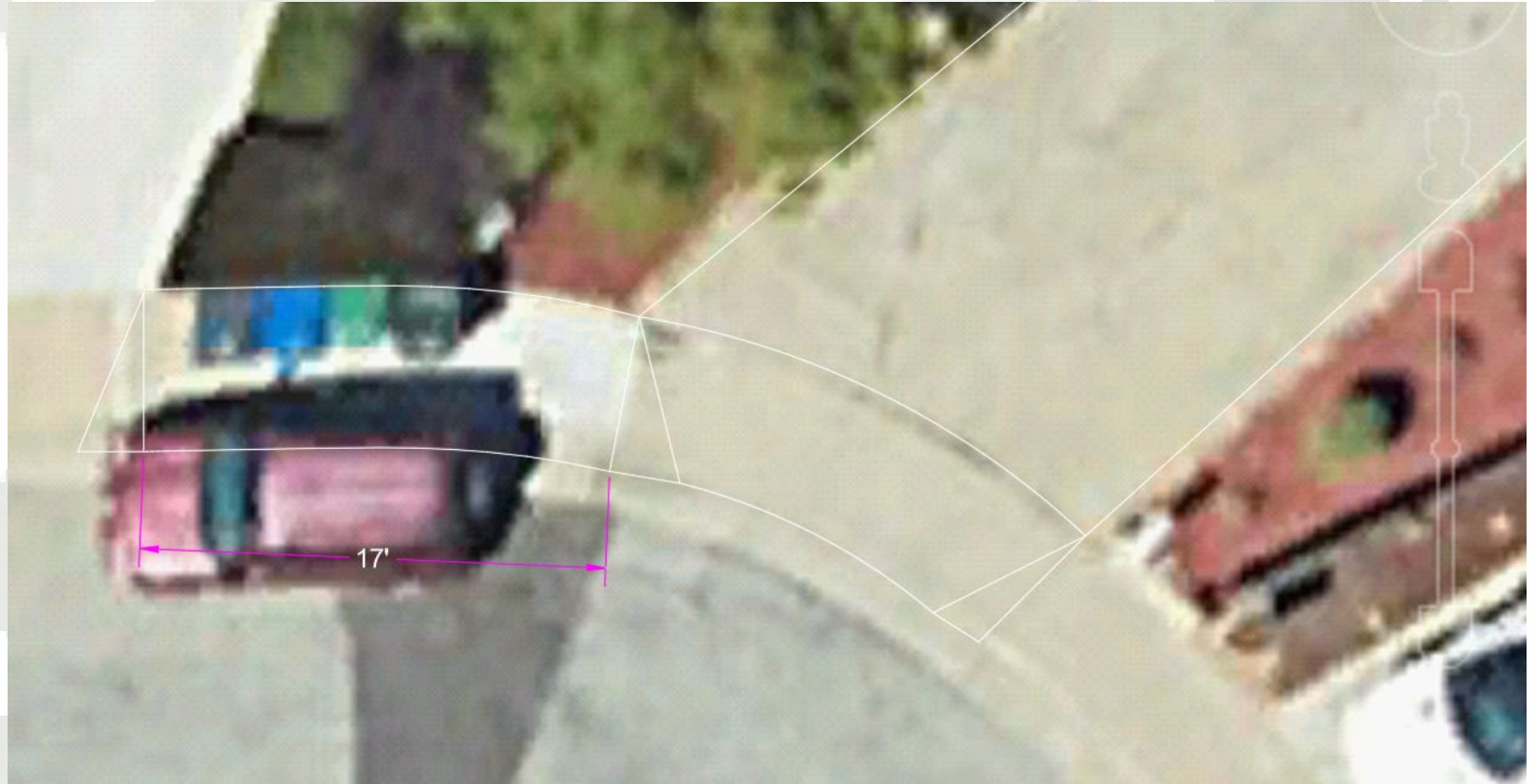

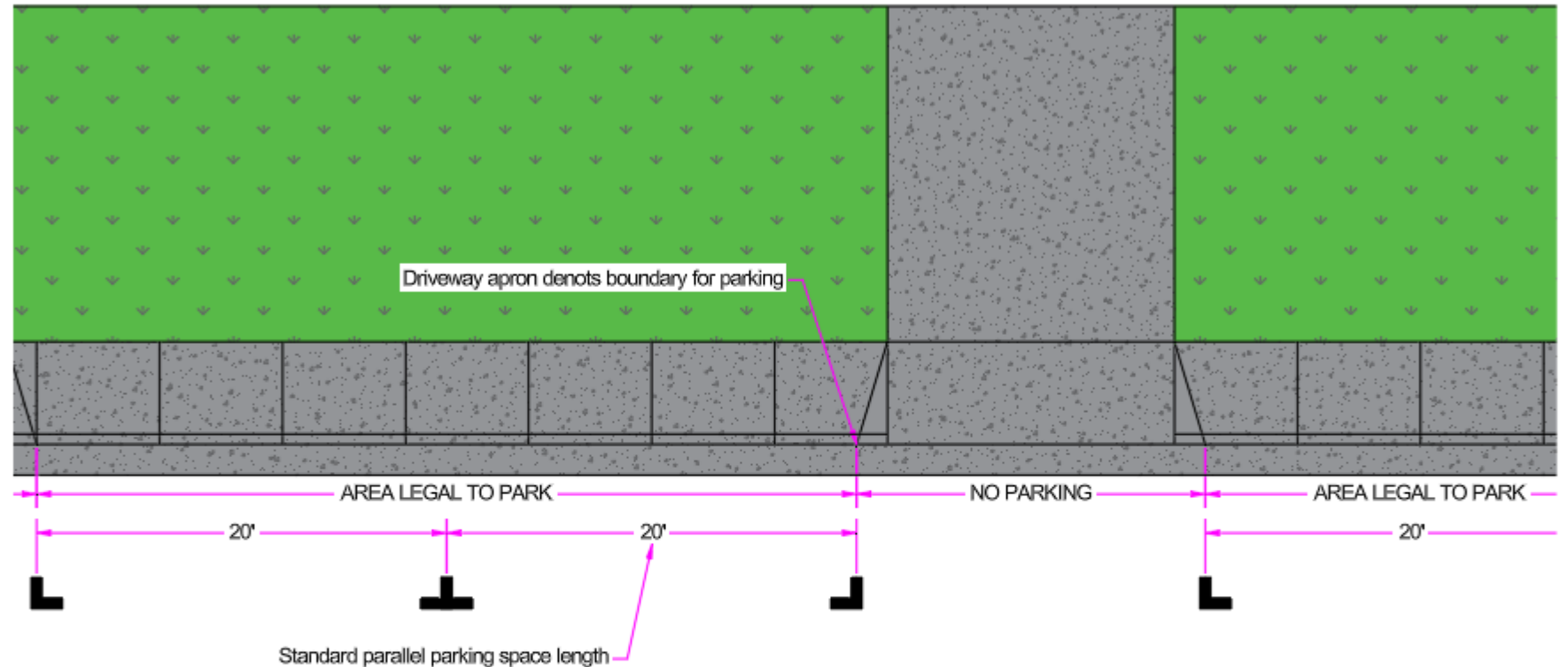
1184 DRIVEWAY CHARACTERISTICS

- Cul-du-Sac is curved.
- Driveway leading to garage accentuates angle at which vehicles approach street.
- Street Parking is shorter than a standard vehicle space.



STANDARD STREET PARKING

NOTE: Vehicles are not allowed to park on the street between a private driveway apron.



CONFLICT

- Vehicles legally parked project over driveway approach.
- 17' space adequate for most vehicles, and a naturally tempting parking space.



EXAMPLE

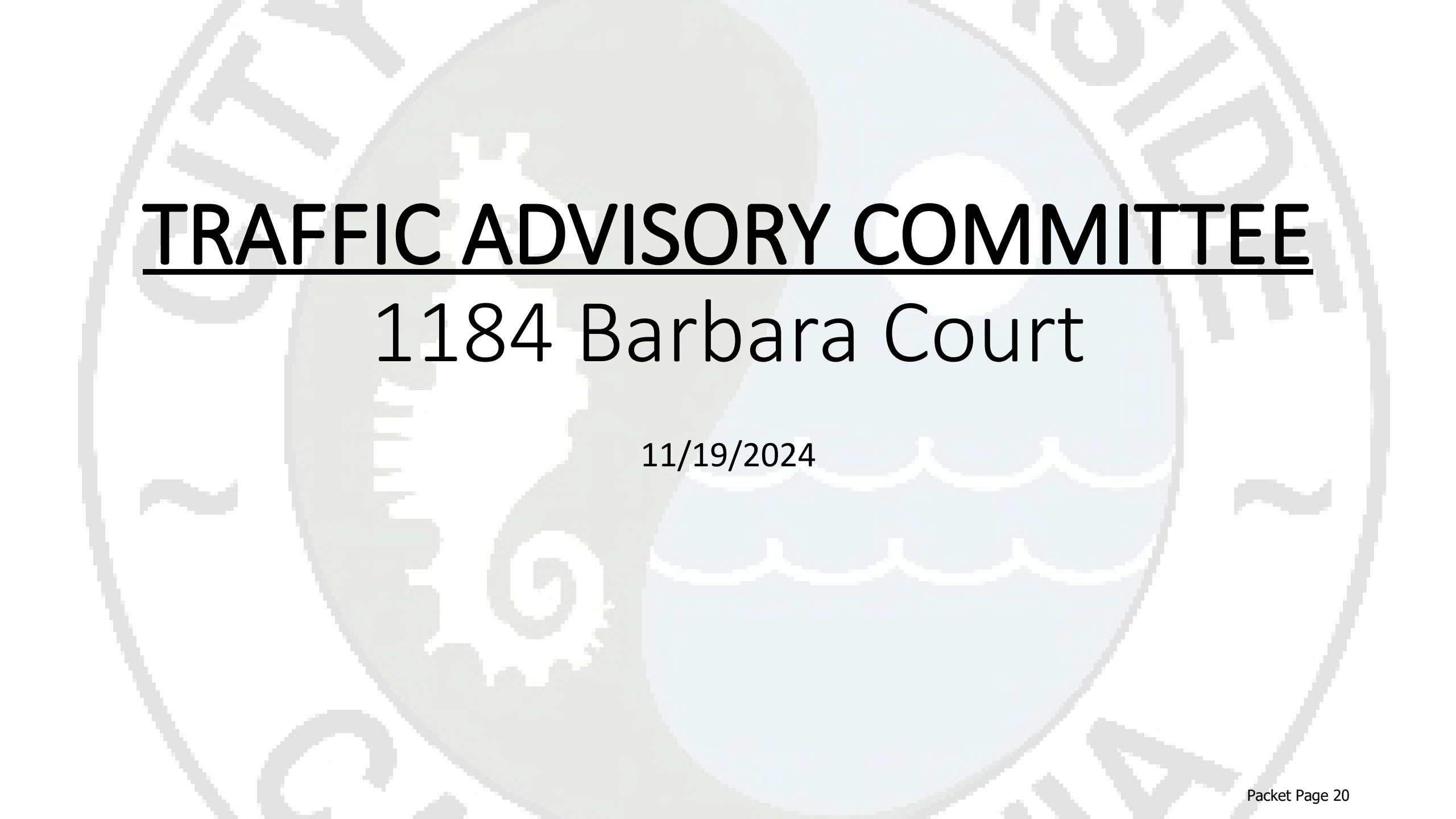
- Legally parked cars on the street in curved cul-du-sac areas will project beyond their driveway apron and block driveway access



SOLUTION

- Project driveway out into street, and paint curb red up to point where standard vehicle if parked will not block driveway access.
- Owner to pay curb painting fee.





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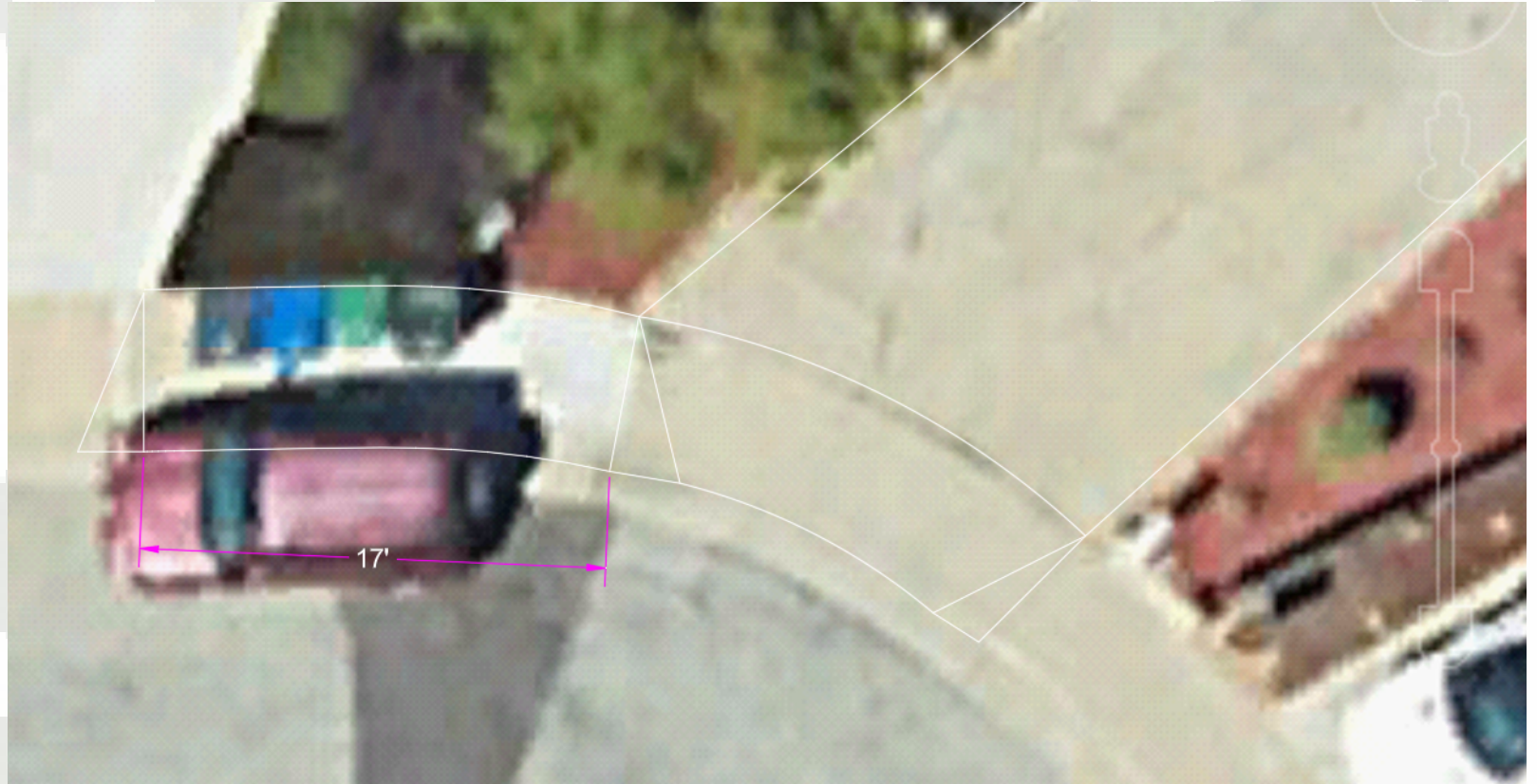
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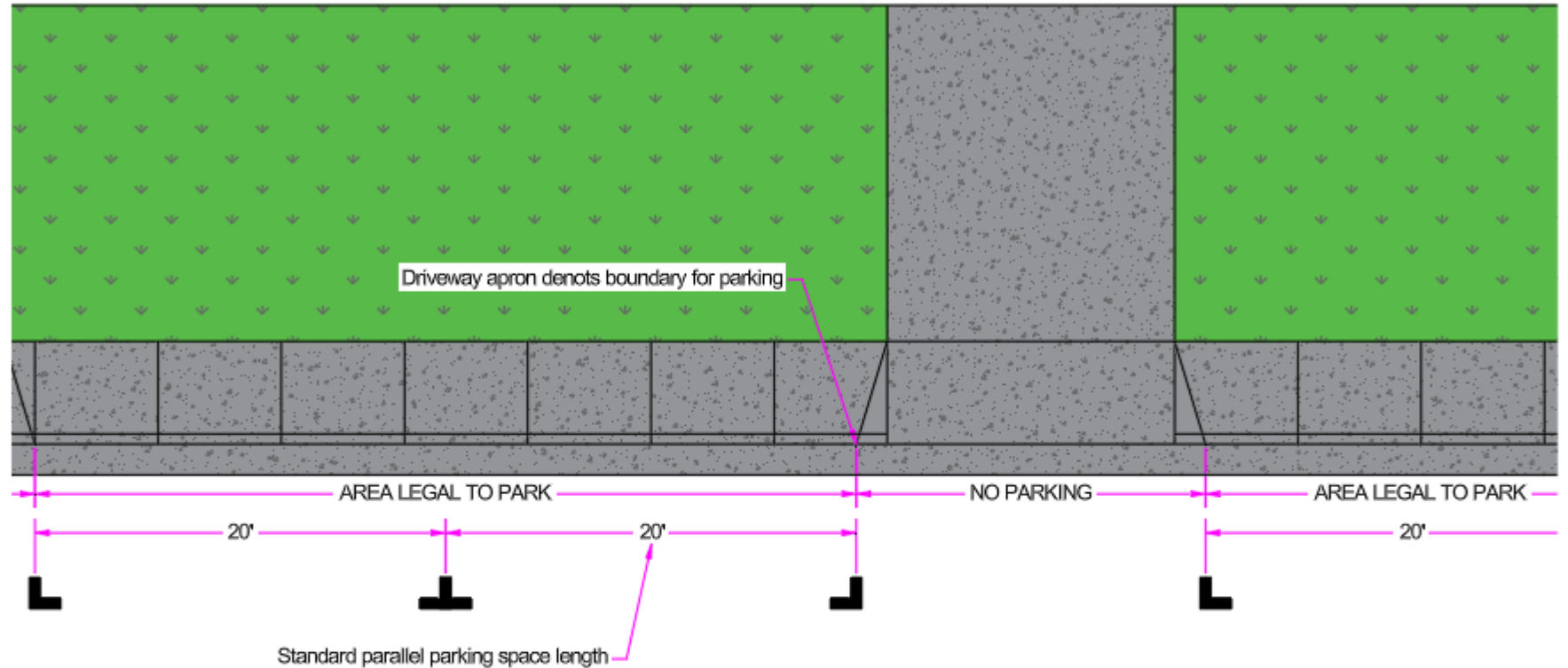
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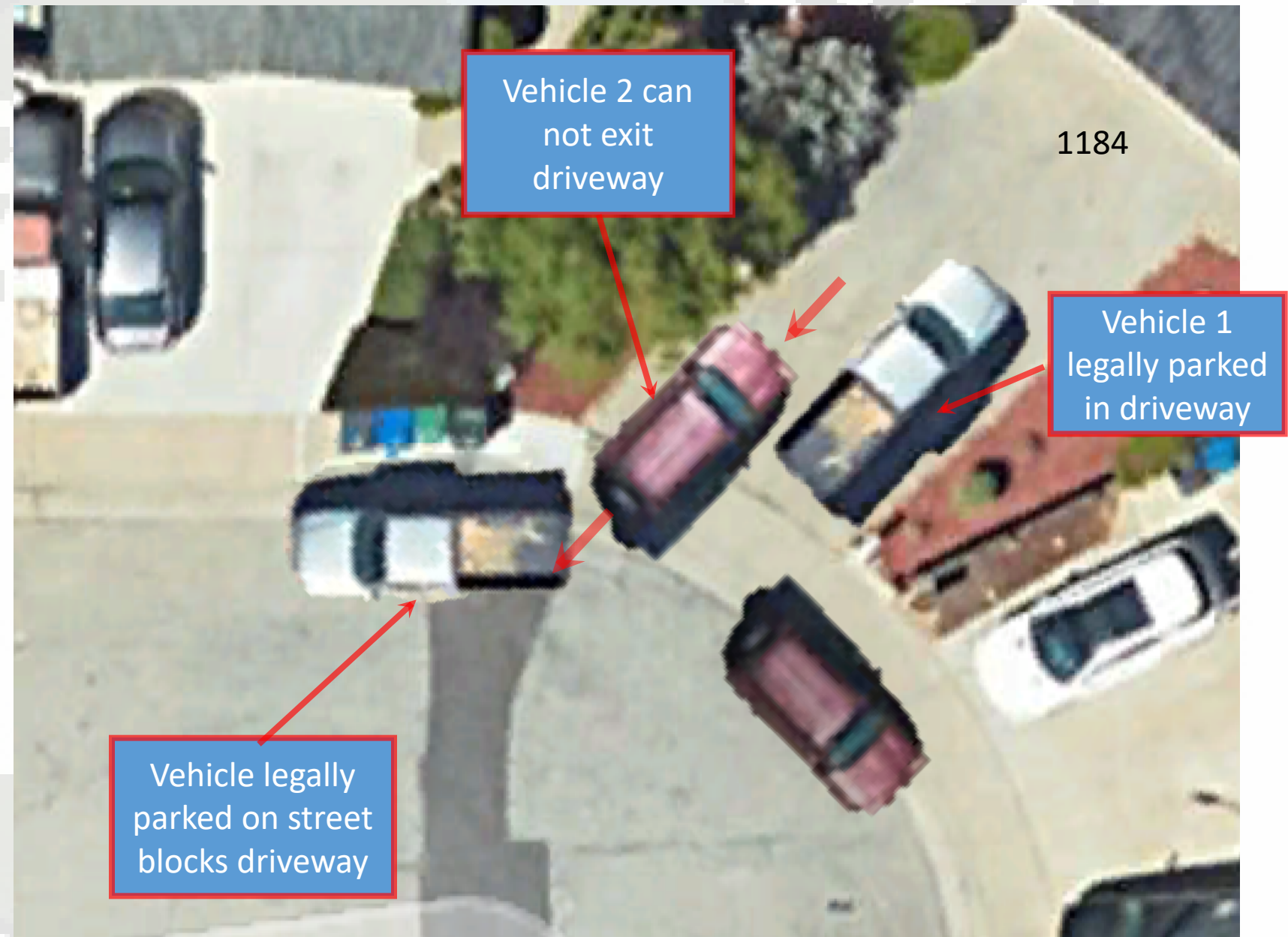
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
