**SUBJECT: APPROVE SPEED CUSHIONS ON PLUMAS AVENUE BETWEEN
1497 AND 1509 PLUMAS AVENUE**

RECOMMENDATION

Approve speed cushions on Plumas Avenue between 1497 and 1509 Plumas Avenue

BACKGROUND

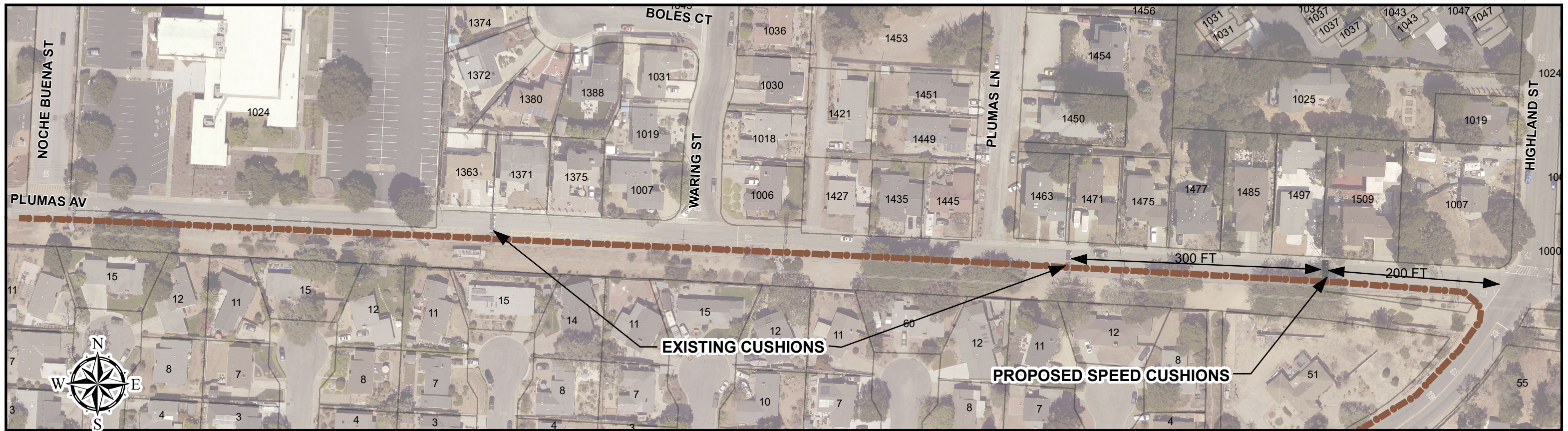
In 2015, two sets of speed cushions were installed on Plumas Avenue near 1363 and 1463 Plumas Avenue. As part of the recent construction of the multi-use trail along the south side of Plumas Avenue, the existing speed cushions were reconfigured, and the remaining sections were salvaged. Additional pieces were purchased to complete another full set. It is recommended to install this extra set of speed cushions between 1497 and 1509 Plumas Avenue. The proposed speed cushions are approximately 200 feet from the Plumas/Highland/Carlton intersection and approximately 300 feet from the set of speed cushions near 1463 Plumas Avenue.

Plumas Avenue Roadway Characteristics

Plumas Avenue is classified as a collector street with a posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour. Plumas Avenue roadway width, measured from face of curb to face of curb, is 28 feet, yielding 10 wide travel lanes and 8 feet for on-street parking along the north side. There is an 8-foot-wide multi-use trail along the south side of Plumas Avenue between Highland Street and Noche Buena Street, installed as part of the Fort Ord Trails And Greenway (FORTAG) project.

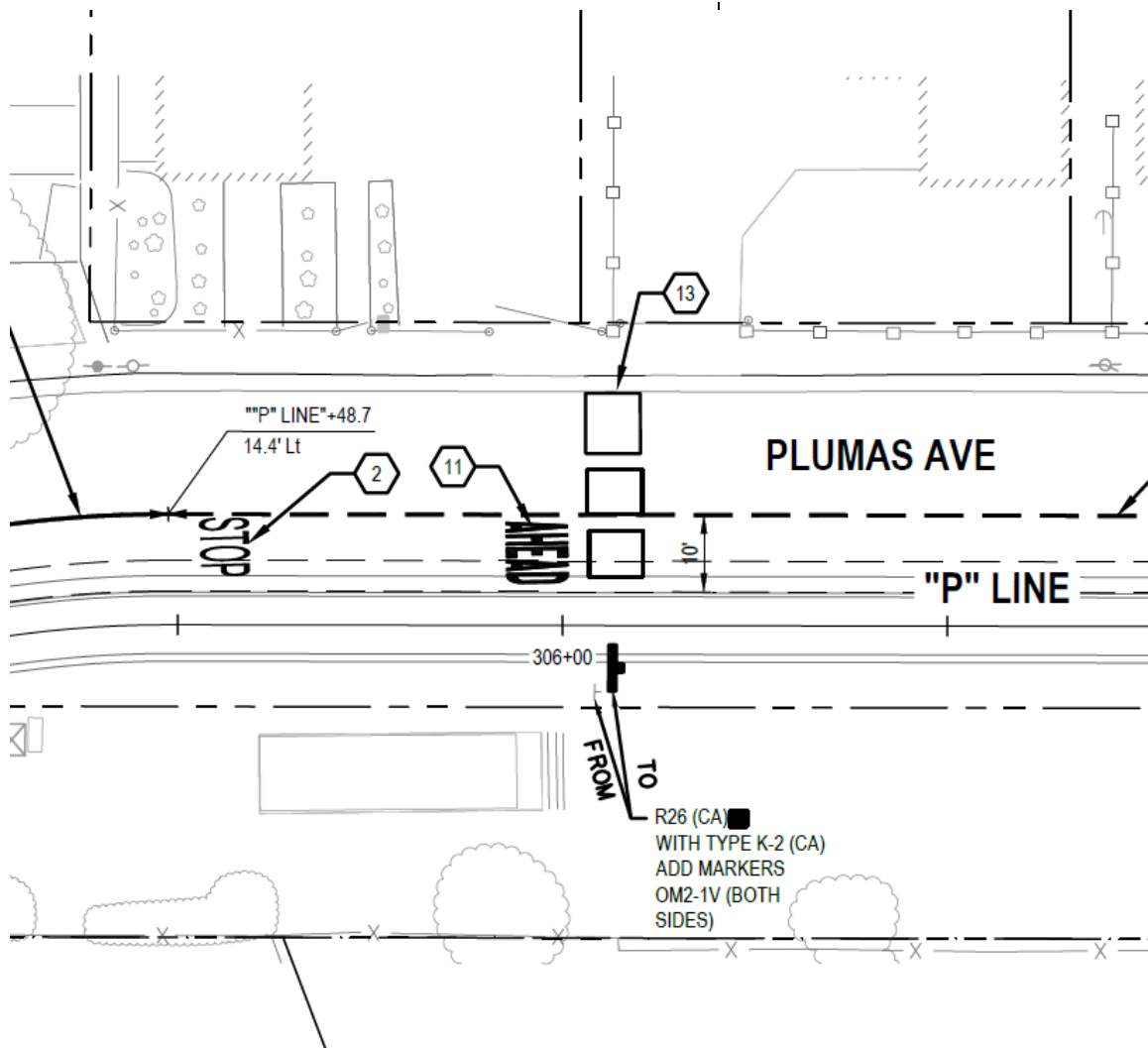
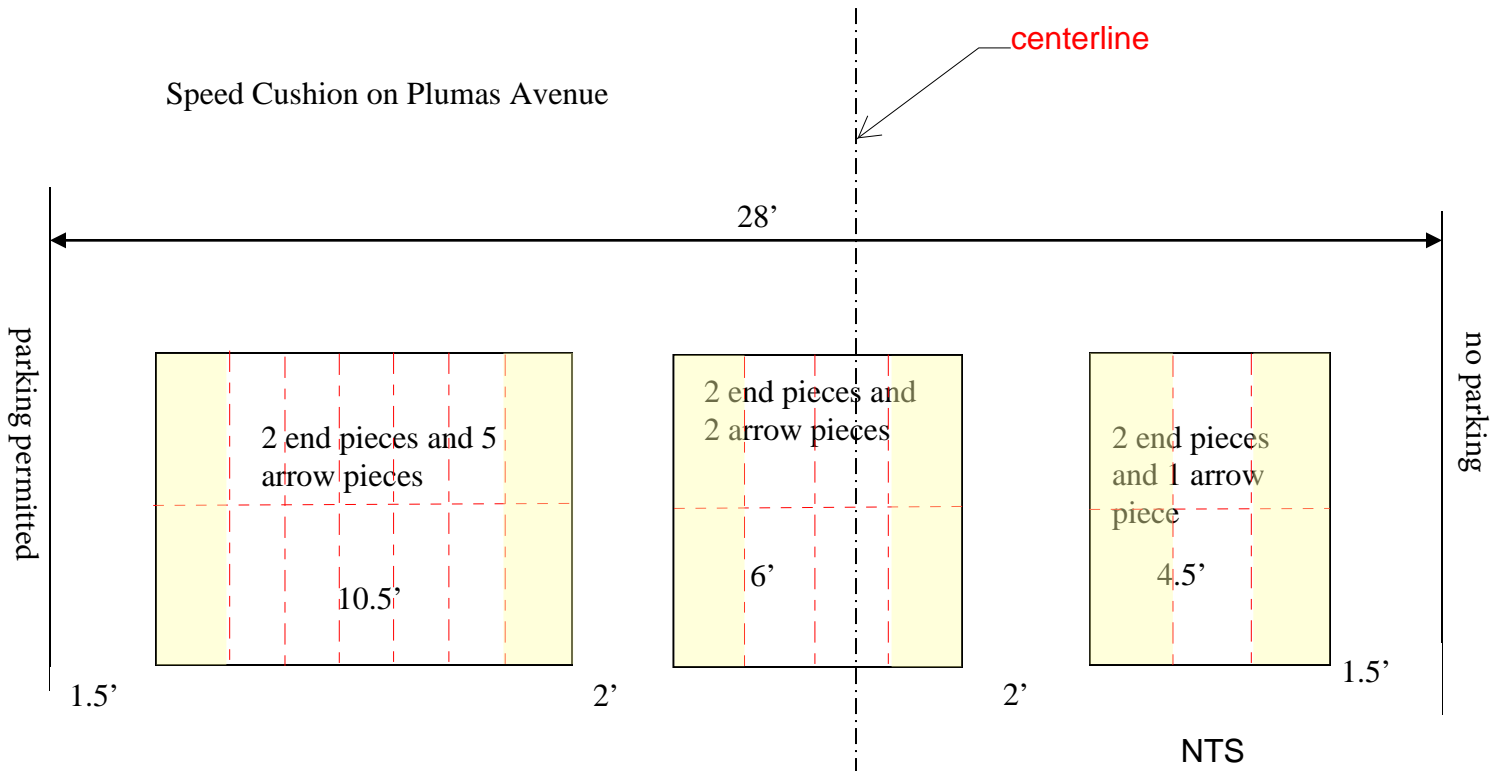



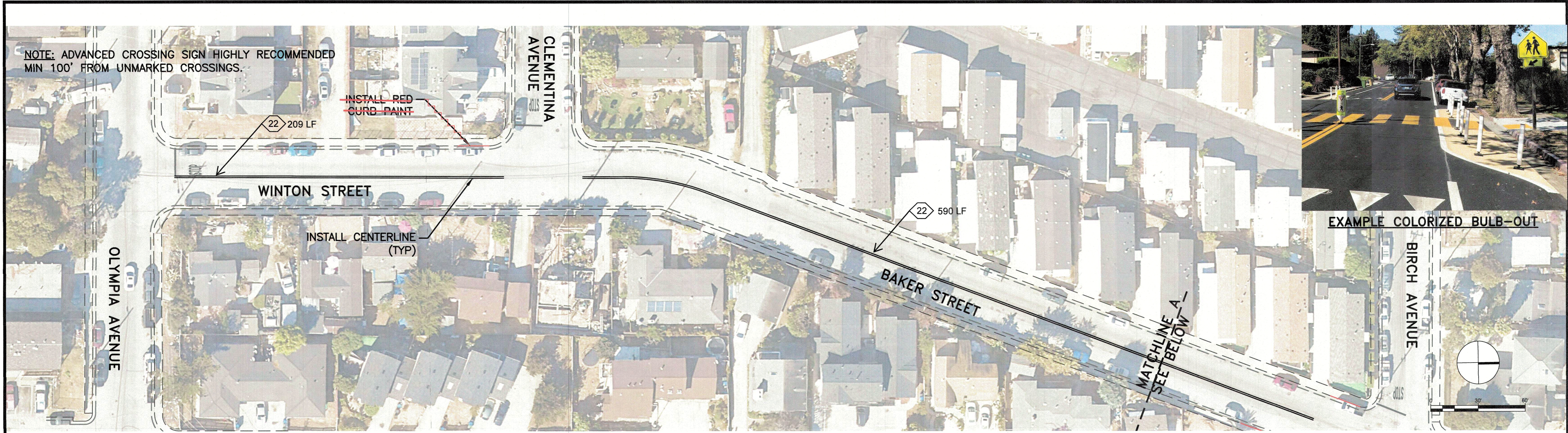

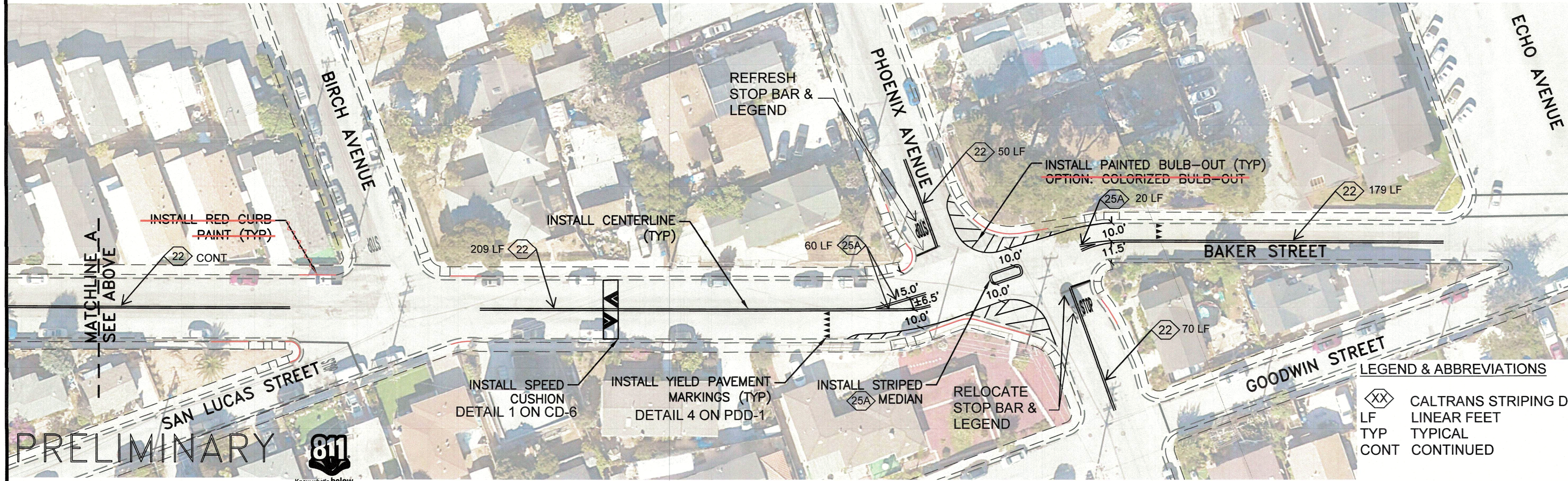

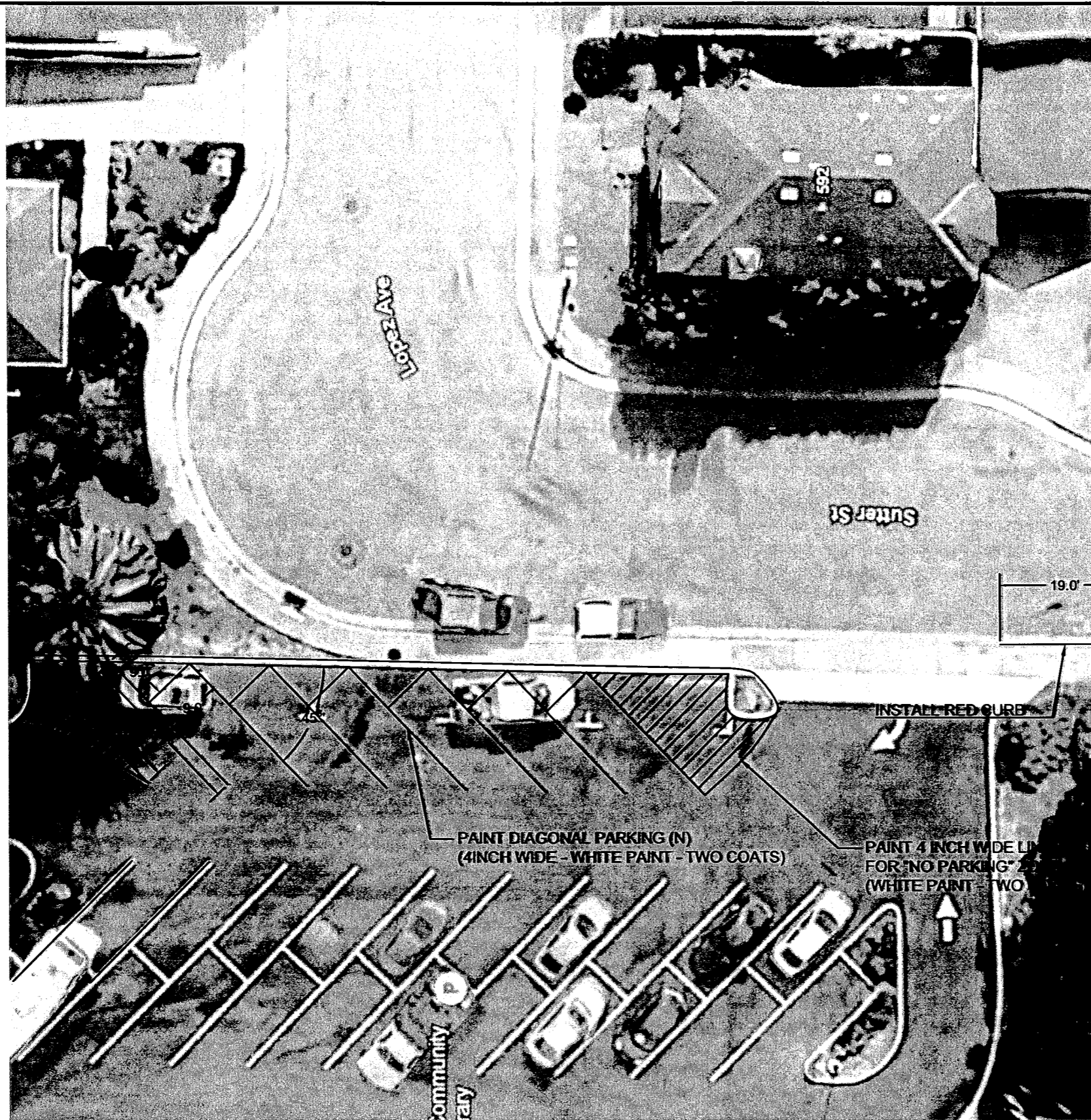
