The city council also reviewed the recommendations from the Neighborhood Improvement Programs and confirmed to proceed with the following projects:

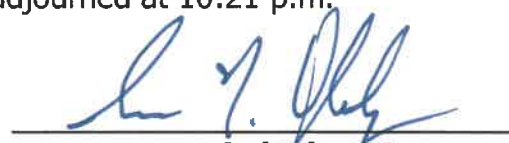
1. Annual Tree Giveaway Program (\$5000).
2. 6 Benches at parks around existing playground equipment-Highland Otis, Lincoln Cunningham, Pacchetti, Capra (\$27,000).
3. Add 2 Wheel chair accessibility ramps to the benches on General Jim Moore (\$4000).
4. 5 wraps on electric boxes (\$8,500).
5. 1 Mural (\$15,000).
6. 3 bikes racks at Lincoln Cunningham Park Basketball court and Havana Soliz Park BBQ area (\$3,900).
7. Laguna Grande Park 10 Benches Replacement and Additions (\$50,000).
8. Install 2 Grandstand/Gazebos at Laguna Grande Park Lakeside BBQ area (\$40,000).
9. Canyon Del Rey Median Landscaping (intersection of Del Monte to CDR) (\$25,000).
