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**PURPOSE**

Receive Seaside County Sanitation District quarterly FOG inspection report and highlights from the recently submitted annual report

**RECOMMENDATION**

Accept report. This item is presented for information only.

**BACKGROUND**

Staff will present on FOG inspections performed from January 1st, 2026 to March 31st, 2026, as well as trend data from SCSD's annual report.

The FOG Management Program in SCSD includes routine inspections of all food service establishments (FSEs) once to twice a year, depending on type. There are currently 165 FSEs within the District, the majority of which are restaurants, but include businesses such as convenience stores, social clubs, and places of worship that are preparing and serving food. There are 285 routine inspections per year, for the 169 facilities. This does not include re-inspections for violations.

During the third quarter of fiscal year 2025/26, SCSD staff performed 34 inspections. Inspections were performed between January 1st and March 25th. Of the 34 inspections, 0 locations had FOG and solids over 25% in their interceptors.
