**A. APPROVE MINUTES OF MAY 18, 2017**

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the minutes be reviewed and approved.

**B. ADOPT A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE REGIONAL ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$458,940 FOR THE PURCHASE OF MOBILE AND PORTABLE RADIOS FOR THE FIRE AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENTS WITH MATCHING FUNDS NOT TO EXCEED \$33,771.**

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this item is to adopt a resolution accepting a Regional Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the amount of \$458,940 (City of Seaside share) for the purchase of replacement mobile and portable radios for the fire and public works departments. As this is a regional grant, the City of Seaside will be acting as host agency and the Greenfield Fire District, City of Gonzales and Mid-Coast Fire Brigade will be participating as well; total grant funds: \$939,063.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the City Council approve the resolution accepting the Regional Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the amount of \$458,940 (City of Seaside share) for the purchase of replacement mobile and portable radios for the fire and public works departments. As this is a regional grant, the City of Seaside will be acting as host agency and the Greenfield Fire District, City of Gonzales and Mid-Coast Fire Brigade will be participating as well; total grant funds: \$939,063. Also, provide direction to the Finance Department to record the grant award in the 2017-2018 Fiscal Budget with matching funds not to exceed \$33,771.

**C. APPROVE THE TRAFFIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE (TAC) RECOMMENDATIONS**

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this item is to consider the Traffic Advisory Committee (TAC) recommendations from their May 16, 2017 regular meeting.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended for the City Council to approve the following:

1. Stop signs on San Pablo Avenue at Mescal Street and refresh crosswalk paint; Remove faded crosswalk located on Yosemite Street north of the International School of Monterey's driveway exit; and retain crosswalks on Yosemite Street at Mingo Avenue and Westminster Court and replace existing school crossing signs for crosswalk and install school ahead signs per the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this agenda item is for the City Council to consider a Three Thousand Dollar (\$3,000) request from Seaside High School Robotics Program for a donation from the Mayor's Youth Fund to help cover the cost of two competitions; one in San Jose and one in Saint Louis, Missouri.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the City Council approve the request.
