a. “Seaside History Society”: Discuss, Plan and Vote:

- * Chairman Wildgoose went over some pros and cons of the possible creation of a Seaside Historical Society. This was discussed & clarified that this type of organization would be considered a separate non-profit entity that the Art & History Commission could conceptually support. Yollette Merritt/Steven Russell M/S/P: “To support the formation of a Seaside History Association”.

b. City Website: Discuss improving History section:

- * The History section of the City’s website was discussed & the commission felt that some revisions to that section could be improved upon & should be made. The chairman suggested that a subcommittee be established to help with recommendations to changes of the history section & asked for volunteers. Chairman Wildgoose, Commissioner Silveria and Merritt volunteered to take on the task & will provide an update at the next meeting in July.

c. Archives: Schedule Work Sessions for summer:

- * The status of the archives was discussed by the commission. Commissioner Merritt suggested that it may be necessary to have the City Council formally approve the archives for the record. Staff will request Leslie Milton, City Clerk, to come to the next Art & History Commission meeting. Commissioner Russell stated he will get with Commissioner Silveria and Avery at the end of June to work on the archives.

d. Oral Histories: List of Interview Candidates for CSUMB:

- * Vice Chairman Wildgoose passed out the flyer from CSUMB professor LaFollette & asked that the commissioners should send her any names & numbers of people in the community who would be interested. Commissioner Merritt suggested that the flyer should mention the City of Seaside or its logo for city promotional purposes. Also, discussed was the ownership of the oral histories as well as the CSUMB MOU. Commissioner Merritt requested a copy of the CSUMB MOU.

e. Chamberlin: Update on possible Archives/History Center/Museum:

- * Since there seems to be no real movement or interest by the city it was suggested that this item should be removed from the agenda for now.

Seaside Voices Oral History Project

Would you like to help students preserve local history?

This fall, CSUMB oral history students will continue to interview Seaside residents to record and celebrate local stories and lives. They would be honored to speak with you about your memories.

If you would like to join the project, a student will contact you during the semester to gather initial information and answer any questions you may have. They will then set up a time and place for the interview that is most comfortable and convenient for you. Interviews typically last 1-1.5 hours. The student will create an audio recording and transcript of the interview. You will receive a copy and a version will be preserved at CSUMB for future research. At the end of the semester, students will share short selections of the interviews at a reading to celebrate the project. We hope you will help in the effort to learn more about the rich history of Seaside!
