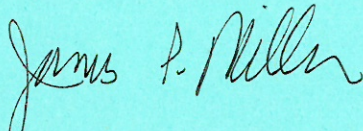
Dear Ms Gray

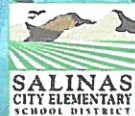

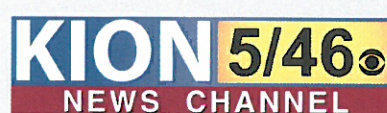
