a. Appointment of a new Chair of Recreation & Parks Commission:

* Commissioners voted on a new Chair and Vice Chair:

b. Review and discuss the 2018/19 proposed budget & CIP for Recreation & Parks:

- * The \$150,000.00 that was approved for 2017-18 is in the general funds not CIP. The Parks projects that were approved are Capra Park - \$28,000.00, Neil Park - \$12,000.00, Portal Project \$40,000.00, Roberts Lake/Painted Peace Poles - \$5,000.00, Ellis Park - \$60,000.00 which equals \$148,000.00.
- * The 2018-19 budget that includes the \$200,000.00 for Parks goes to the next City Council meeting on July 05, 2018 for approval.

c. Discuss strategies on increasing public awareness for park improvement projects:

- * The commissioners discussed how to improve the small parks and the rundown Parks and what would work best. They discussed which parks get watered and how much water is needed.
- * The commissioners discussed getting the community involved in their neighborhood parks. There are 26 parks. They discussed inviting the community (in groups) to several Parks & Recreation meetings to educate them about their neighborhood parks.

d. Name the Coot Contest Vote:

- * Commissioners voted and turned in their ballots to staff.

5. REPORTS FROM RECREATION STAFF:

- * Staff reported that Roberts Lake is coming along. The ribbon cutting clean-up is on July 12, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- * Staff reported that they will find out if they will be getting the \$50,000.00 grant for Ellis Park later this week.
- * Staff reported that the 4th of July fireworks and celebration at the Bayonet Black Horse Golf Course from 4:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Staff handed out information about the event. There will be three shuttle bus locations: Oldemeyer Center, Boys and Girls Club and Villa Del Monte apartments.

6. REPORTS FROM PARKS STAFF:

- * Staff reported they had meeting last week with the Mescal Neil Park group in regards to the \$12,000.00. They had a lot of great projects; however, some of them are very costly. There was one neighbor had a concern about the pergola being in his backyard. Staff has come up with a design for the \$12,000.00 and will be talking to the group again for approval.

- * Staff reported that the Portal Project is moving forward and the sign for Pacchetti Park has been ordered. The Parks department will install it.

7. REPORTS FROM COMMISSIONERS:

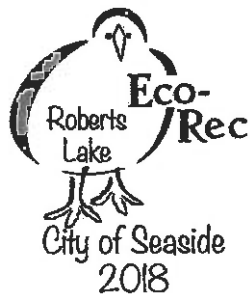

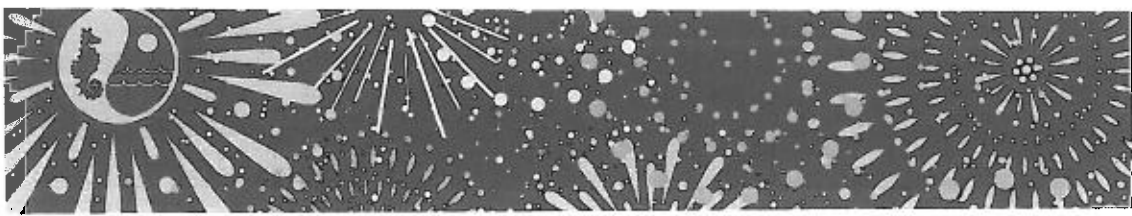

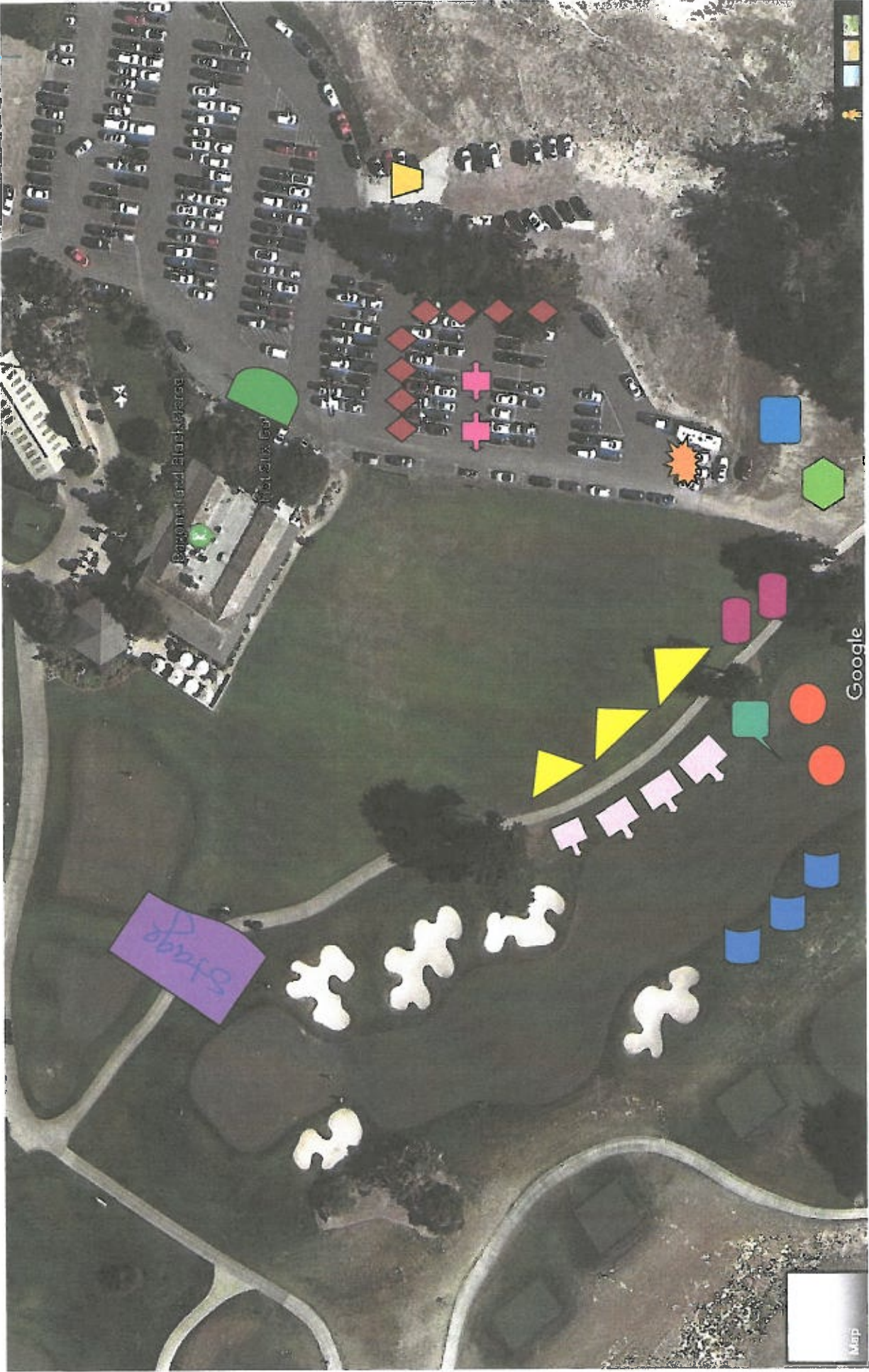
