PURPOSE & RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution certifying the Canvass of Returns of the Consolidated General Municipal Election for the City of Seaside held on November 6, 2018 and declare the official winners of the election as Ian Oglesby for the position of Mayor and Jason Campbell and Jon Wizard for the positions of City Council Member.

BACKGROUND

On May 19, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-XX, authorizing the consolidation of the General Municipal Election in the City of Seaside with the Statewide General Election. The General Municipal Election was held as required by law for the object and purpose of electing one person to the Office of Mayor, for a two-(2) year term, and electing to the Offices of Council Member, two (2) officials, each to a four-(4) year term.

The General Election was held in the State of California on November 6, 2018, and in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of City of Seaside Municipal Code and the Elections Code of the State of California.

The County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election as required by law and has certified the vote results for the City of Seaside as follows:

A Certified Statement of the Votes Cast and the Final Official Report from the Registrar of Voters are attached. California Elections Code §10262 requires the governing body of a city, upon completion of the canvass and before installing new officers, to pass a resolution reciting the facts of the election. Adoption of the resolution will allow the new City Council to be seated.

It is recommended that the City Council declare the following by adoption of the attached resolution:

- All absentee and provisional voter ballots have been duly received and canvassed in the time, form and manner, as required by law.
- The whole number of votes cast in said General Municipal Election for the City of Seaside was 8,140.
- The record of votes cast at the November 6, 2018 election has been certified by Monterey County Registrar of Voters as listed above.
- The City Clerk of the City of Seaside is instructed to enter this resolution in the minutes of this City Council Meeting as the Official Result of said election and to forward a copy of this Resolution to the County of Monterey
- Election Department to certify that the City Council adopted the canvass of the vote as submitted by the Monterey County Registrar of Voters.
- Declare that Ian Oglesby was elected to the office of Mayor for a two(2) year term and that Jason Campbell and Jon Wizard were re-elected/elected to office as members of the City Council, each with a term of four (4) years and can take their oath of office and be seated as members of the Seaside governing body.

WHEREAS, said General Municipal Election and Consolidated Statewide General Election held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, was properly noticed as required by law, voting precincts were properly established and election officers were appointed and in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of City of Seaside Municipal Code and the Elections Code of the State of California;

WHEREAS, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election as required by law and has certified the results to this City Council, and the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEASIDE HEREBY DECLARES THAT:

- All absentee and provisional voter ballots have been duly received and canvassed in the time, form and manner, as required by law.
- The whole number of votes cast in said General Municipal Election for the City of Seaside was 8,140.
- The record of votes cast at the November 6, 2018 election has been certified by Monterey County Registrar of Voters.

REPORT OF THE MANUAL TALLY STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 6, 2018

1% Manual Tally of Paper Ballots: The 1% manual tally is defined by Elections Code §336.5 as the public process of manually tallying votes in one percent of the batches, selected at random by the election official and in one batch for each race not included in the randomly selected batches. This procedure is conducted during the official canvass to verify the accuracy of the automated count. This tally includes paper ballots cast at the polling place or by mail.

On Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at 2:00 p.m., the Department conducted a public random selection of batches for the 1% manual tally. The Department randomly rolled 5 ten-sided dice to select combinations of counting group, ImageCast Central (ICC) scanner and batch number.

Two dice were used to select the counting group and ICC scanner, respectively.

Three dice were used to select the 100's, 10's and 1's digits, of the batch number, respectively.

Results of the 1% Manual Tally of paper ballots: During the 1% manual tally, the Department encountered no variances and confirmed the accuracy of the results from the ImageCast™ Central (ICC) paper ballot tabulation and adjudication system is accurate.

100% Manual Tally of Electronic Ballots: Under the Top to Bottom Review and conditions set by the Secretary of State of California to use AVC Edge II touch-screen voting machines in an election, it is required that 100% of the votes be manually tallied and results compared to the machine's results.

Results of the 100% Manual Tally of electronic ballots: During the 100% manual tally, the Department encountered no variances. This verified the results of each AVC Edge II (touch-screen) voting machine are accurate.
