**SUBJECT: CONSIDER ADDITION OF WAYFINDING SIGNS FOR FORT ORD
NATIONAL MONUMENT**

PURPOSE & RECOMMENDATION

The purpose of this item is for the Traffic Advisory Committee to consider approving six wayfinding signs to be installed at prominent locations for the purpose of directing vehicles to the Fort Ord National Monument access route from Gigling Road. It is recommended that the Traffic Advisory Committee approve the wayfinding signs.

BACKGROUND

Fort Ord is a National Monument, as identified by the Bureau of Land Management, and recognized for its history as a leading Army training center and deployment staging ground from 1917 until 1994. The area has remained largely undeveloped and now provides more than 86 miles of trails, with a diversity of plant and animal habitats. The addition of these signs will be located at prominent locations to help the community, visitors, and new residents of the city, find the Fort Ord National Monument more easily.

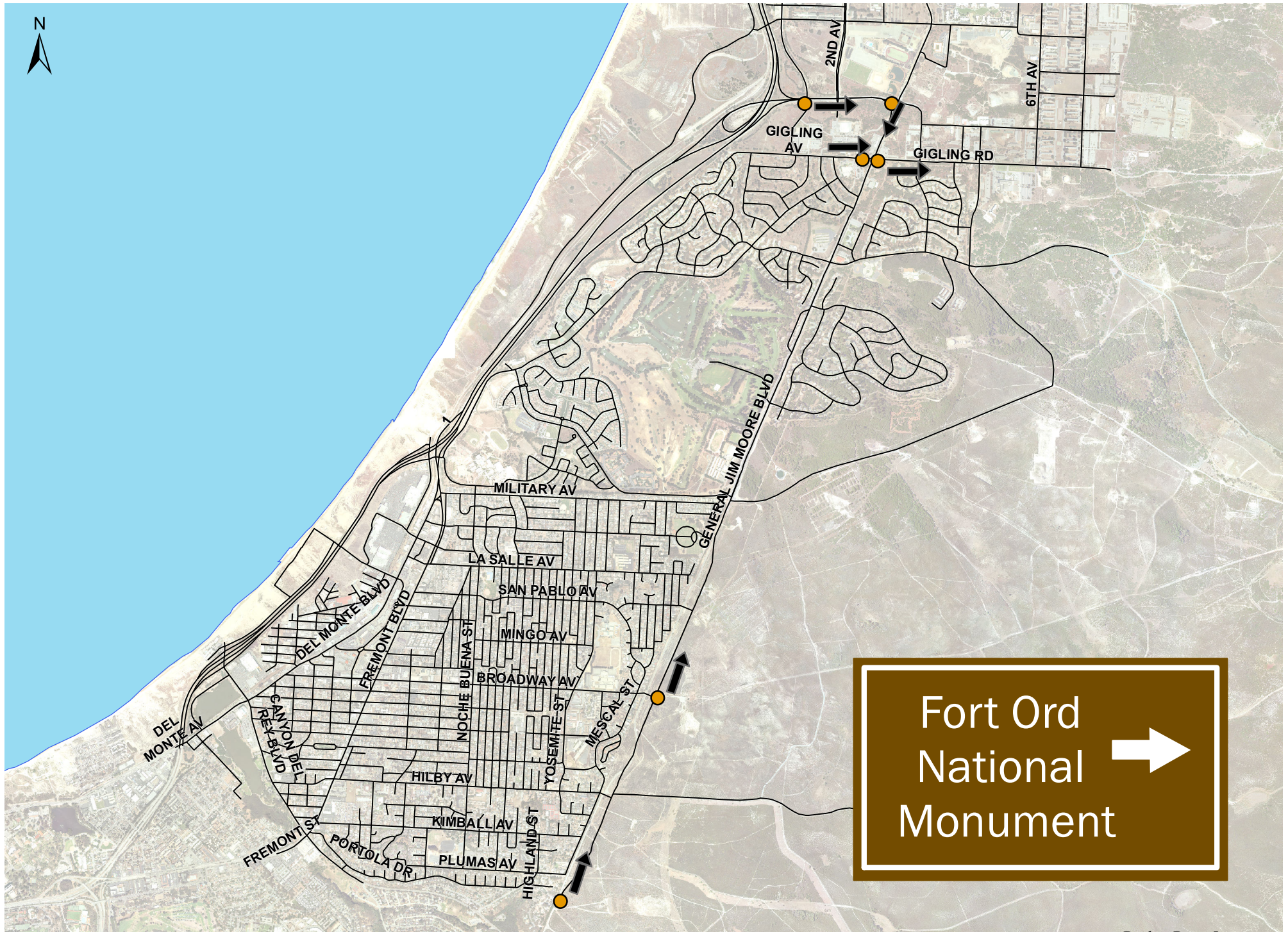
STAFF ANALYSIS

Currently there are no wayfinding signs for the Fort Ord National Monument. Chapters 2D and 9 of the MUTCD provides standard design of wayfinding signs and placement of signs, respectively. The signs shall be 36 inches by 22 inches, printed on Recreation Brown high intensity prismatic sheeting. The signs shall conform to the standard in shape, legend, and color per the MUTCD standards. The signs shall be mounted to 4x4 Pressure-Treated Douglas Fir wood posts and utilizing existing sign posts where available. Signs shall be installed by City Staff. If new sign posts are to be installed, they shall require underground clearance with Underground Service Alert and hand-digging for the post holes. Signs and new posts will be located within the public right of way behind the back of the sidewalks at the locations shown in Attachment 1.
