RECOMMENDATION: Receive a presentation by Everyone's Harvest. Discuss and provide input regarding EC involvement.

C. SUPPORT FROM PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE REGARDING BEE CITY USA AND POLLINATOR SITES; OUTREACH TO FRIENDS OF SEASIDE PARKS ASSOCIATION, AND PROCLAMATION RE POLLINATOR WEEK.

RECOMMENDATION: The purpose of this item is for the EC to become aware of the support of the Parks and Recreation Committee regarding BEE CITY sites and outreach to community groups.

D. BEE CITY POLLINATOR SITE PROPOSAL AND FUTURE SITE SELECTION

RECOMMENDATION: Discuss partnership between the Friends of the Seaside Library and the EC to work on replacing the ivy with sustainable, drought-resistant plants.

It's recommended the EC discuss this collaboration and identify how it could also be expanded to meet some obligations of Bee City USA and possibly expanded to include pollinator-friendly improvements to Stephen E. Ross Memorial Park (former mayor of the city of Seaside from 1978-1980, mayor pro-tem 1966-1972, and 1976-1978, council 1964-1978).

RECOMMENDATION: Receive presentation from the EC subcommittee regarding the plans associated with the Environmentally Preferred Plastics code amendments, community outreach, and outreach and education plans.

It's recommended the EC provide feedback on approach, volunteer to be involved in efforts, and make suggestions on information provided.
