A. CONSIDER TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL TWO WEEK POP UP PLAN LOCATED ON BROADWAY AVENUE BETWEEN YOSEMITE STREET AND MESCAL STREET

- Misty, Associate Engineer, City of Seaside introduced Amelia Conlen from Ecology Action to present the Seaside Safe Routes to School Pop-Up Demonstration Concept Plan
- Amelia presented the SRTS Pop-Up Demonstration Concept Plan that will be funded by Measure X and CalTrans Planning Grant.
- Amelia asked for Fire Chief Dempsey's input on the materials used since this area is used heavily by Fire.
- Pacheco asked about notification and Amelia said there will be notice as well as an electronic board notifying the community.
- Amelia said that the MLK School is on board and will ask the school about removing parking on the North side for the duration of the Pop-up.
- Pacheco mentioned concern about the appearance with certain materials used and Amelia stated that it will look better if the lane is buffered because of the materials that can be used for a buffered lane offers better appearance options.
- Pacheco asked Deputy Chief Veloz if the Police Department would be around during the duration of the Pop-up to help monitor. Deputy Chief Veloz confirmed that the Police Department will be around.
- Amelia stated that they will be partnering with the schools to have a bike and walk to school day to coincide with the Pop-up within the first couple of days.
- Rick Medina requested resident map on the percentage of residents who attend the school in the area. Amelia will follow up.

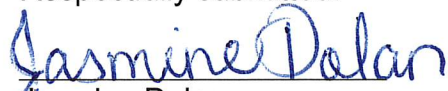
