The Commission has no reports at this time.

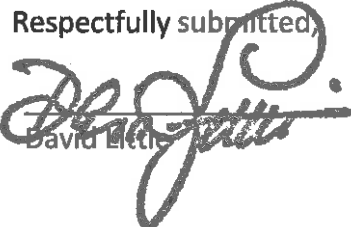
9. ADJOURNMENT 6:53p.m.
