4. PUBLIC COMMENTS:

- * Kora Sabrano gave an update on her application about renaming Capra Park to her father's name (Irvin Herod). She is waiting for a letter from the Seaside Fire Department to go along with her application.
- * Staff reported that they received an email from Constance Constable in regards to a proposal about a Pickleball court in Seaside. Pickleball is a healthy, (mostly) outdoor activity, played on a badminton-sized court over a 36" net. Constance represents the present and future Seaside players of Pickleball. There are three objectives that we would like to propose to the city of Seaside:
 1. Pickleball added to the future plan for Parks and Recreation.
 2. Pickleball allowed on a trial basis, with temporary lines on the courts at Wheeler Street.
 3. Lines for pickleball courts painted on the tennis courts at Wheeler Street.

Allowing pickleball on a trial basis could happen fairly soon. Players could use painter's tape to line the courts, and remove the tape when they are done playing. There is currently a sign outside the courts stating, "Only Tennis is allowed on Tennis Courts". Constance is not sure how to make the public aware that Pickleball would also be allowed on a trial basis. The first and third bulleted items are long-term objectives. Adding Pickleball to future plans, and obtaining permission and funding to have courts painted will take time. Constance stated she plans to attend the December 16, 2019 Parks and Recreation meeting to discuss the Pickleball proposal.

6. BUSINESS ITEMS:

a. Update on the Basketball Court on the corner of Contra Costa Street and Sonoma Avenue:

* Staff reported that they presented the five choices of a Basketball Court, Futsal Court, Community Garden, Skateboarding Park or Bocce Ball Court to the City Council. The City Council voted to keep the property as a basketball court/multi-use court. A survey will not go out to the public. Staff and the Commissioners discussed what improvements would need to be done. Staff stated that the estimate cost for the improvements of the basketball court is about \$150,000.00 to \$200,000.00.

* Public Comment: Ray Bennett reported that Neighbor Improvement Commission has \$50,000.00 for this project or another project.

b. Update on the remaining Dog Stations:

* Staff reported that there are nine dog waste stations are left to install. The Parks & Recreation Commissioners voted and accepted to recommend that Public Works install the remaining dog waste stations. Rich Cadigan/Alicia Louise Gaines-Lynch M/S/P

c. Discuss marketing strategies for the Parks & Recreation Commission table at events:

* Commissioners discussed having a visual display for the table at events. They also discussed teaming up with the Environmental Committee, the Neighborhood Improvement Commission and the Art & History Commission.

**d. Discuss and approve a dollar amount for the Parks & Recreation Commission
Swag items:**

- * Staff handed out books with different swag items. Commissioners will take them home and bring their ideas back at the next Parks & Recreation meeting. The Parks & Recreation Commissioners voted and accepted on spending up to \$1,000.00 on swag items for the Commission. Willie Gray/James White M/S/P

- * Staff reported that Rick Riedl, Public Works Director/City Engineer is retiring and his last day will be on November 27, 2019.

- * Commissioner Maxwell, Commissioner Gaines-Lynch, Commissioner Nielson, and Commissioner White went to the CPRS Region 2 Mini Conference on Thursday, November 14, 2019. They all said the conference was very informative.
- * Commissioner Neilson suggested that the Commissioner attend the JPA meetings. They are reviving the JPA for Laguna Grande Park and they want to create more activity in the park and make it more user friendly. Commissioner Neilson asked the Commissions if they knew of any other parks that are troublesome or needs more clean up or need more activity. Landscaping, fencing, maintenance and keeping the parks clean in Seaside was discussed.
- * Commissioner Neilson reported that she contacted David Jackson and told him that the Parks & Recreation Commission voted on going forward with the wheelchair-accessible swing project at Laguna Grande Park.
- * Commissioner Maxwell reported the FOSPA is cutting down the over grown pampas grass on General Jim Moore near the San Pablo gate on Saturday, November 23, 2019. After that they will be doing some clean up at Highland Otis Park. This will start at 10:00 a.m.

* Commissioner Maxwell stated that he will be going to the Community Development Advisory Committee meeting that will be for potential applicants for Community Development Block Grant funds from the City of Seaside. The meeting is on Wednesday November 20, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at Seaside Creates.
