c. Discussion on Alternative Wheelchair- Accessible play equipment:

- * Staff reported that the Wheelchair-Accessible Swing is not certified in the United States. Staff gave the Commissioners handed out of examples of alternative Wheelchair-accessible equipment.
- * The Commissioners voted and accepted to go forward with the Inclusive Whirl (ADA Merry Go Round) and the Merry Musical with the help of staff to adjust the musical component to fit the \$50,000.00 budget guidelines.

e. Revisit Discussion on Pickleball for Recommendation to City Council:

- * Commissioners discussed what the news reported on Pickleball at the Pacific Grove tennis courts. The news stated that they have Pickleball on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 9:00a.m. to 6:00 p.m. It is first come first serve or you can reserve a court for \$20.00.
- * The Commissioners reported that at Meadowbrook Tennis Courts in Seaside there is two Pickleball courts, however, there is a fee to play on those courts.
- * Commissioners and staff discussed changing the Commissioners recommendation to the City Council about having Pickleball at the Wheeler Street tennis courts.
- * The Commissioners voted and accepted to change their recommendation to the City Council to allow Pickleball at the Wheeler Street Tennis Courts on two courts on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday from opening to closing. There would be temporary signage and a trial period of six months. Also, allowing players to lay down painter's tape to line the courts and remove the tape after they are done.

- * Commissioner Neilson has not heard anything on the Regional Parks grant that she requested. She stated that she liked the alternative Wheelchair-accessible equipment.
- * Commissioner Cadigan reported that he was looking at the SeeClickFix and he saw an issue that was posted a few days ago about someone taking their daughter or grand daughter to Ego Park at Roberts Lake and did not feel save because of all the homeless that were there. Commissioner Cadigan stated that he went over Ego Park at Roberts Lake to check it out. There was a tent, two bikes with trailers, carts full of stuff, two RV's with trash outside them. There was one homeless person laying halfway in one of the parking spots and one homeless person just roaming around. Commissioner Cadigan feels that something needs to be done. He stated he will go to the next City Council and speak up on this matter.
- * Commissioner White reported that there is a homeless and illegal drug problem at Capra Park too. Kora stated she has spoken to the police about this issue. Other neighbors have call the police about this issue too.
- * Commissioner Maxwell reported that he has been over to Roberts Lake late at night and there are several overnight campers there that needs to be addressed. He stated that there was a special meeting with all the Commission Chairs and the Mayor. They talked about the responsibilities of the Chair, how important attendance is at each Commission meeting, code of conduct, what the City Council priorities are and the work plan of each Commission that is due in April 2020.
