SUBJECT: APPROVE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM HOMELESS COMMISSION BUDGET FOR LOCAL FOOD PANTRIES TO RE-STOCK DUE TO COVID-19 CRISIS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00.

PURPOSE & RECOMMENDATION

Approve allocation of funds from Homeless Commission budget for local food pantries to re-stock due to the Covid-19 crisis in the amount of \$5,000.00. Funds to be distributed: \$1,250.00 each to Greater Victory Temple, Saint Francis Xavier Church, Lighthouse Baptist Church and Bethel Missionary Baptist Church.

BACKGROUND

On August 15, 2019, City Council approved a resolution authorizing the transfer of \$5,000.00 from FY19/20 City budgeted funds from the City Council budget to the Homeless Commission budget. The purpose of the transfer; when the Commission is made aware of opportunities and issues that need immediate attention, the Commission could act swiftly to respond to the immediate needs of the community prior to the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting.

Due to impacts from the Covid-19 crisis on local food pantries, the Homeless Commission wishes to distribute \$1,250.00 each to four local pantries: Greater Victory Temple 1620 Broadway Ave., Saint Francis Xavier Church 1475 LaSalle Ave., Lighthouse Baptist Church 1030 Hilby Ave. and Bethel Missionary Baptist Church 390 Elm Ave.
